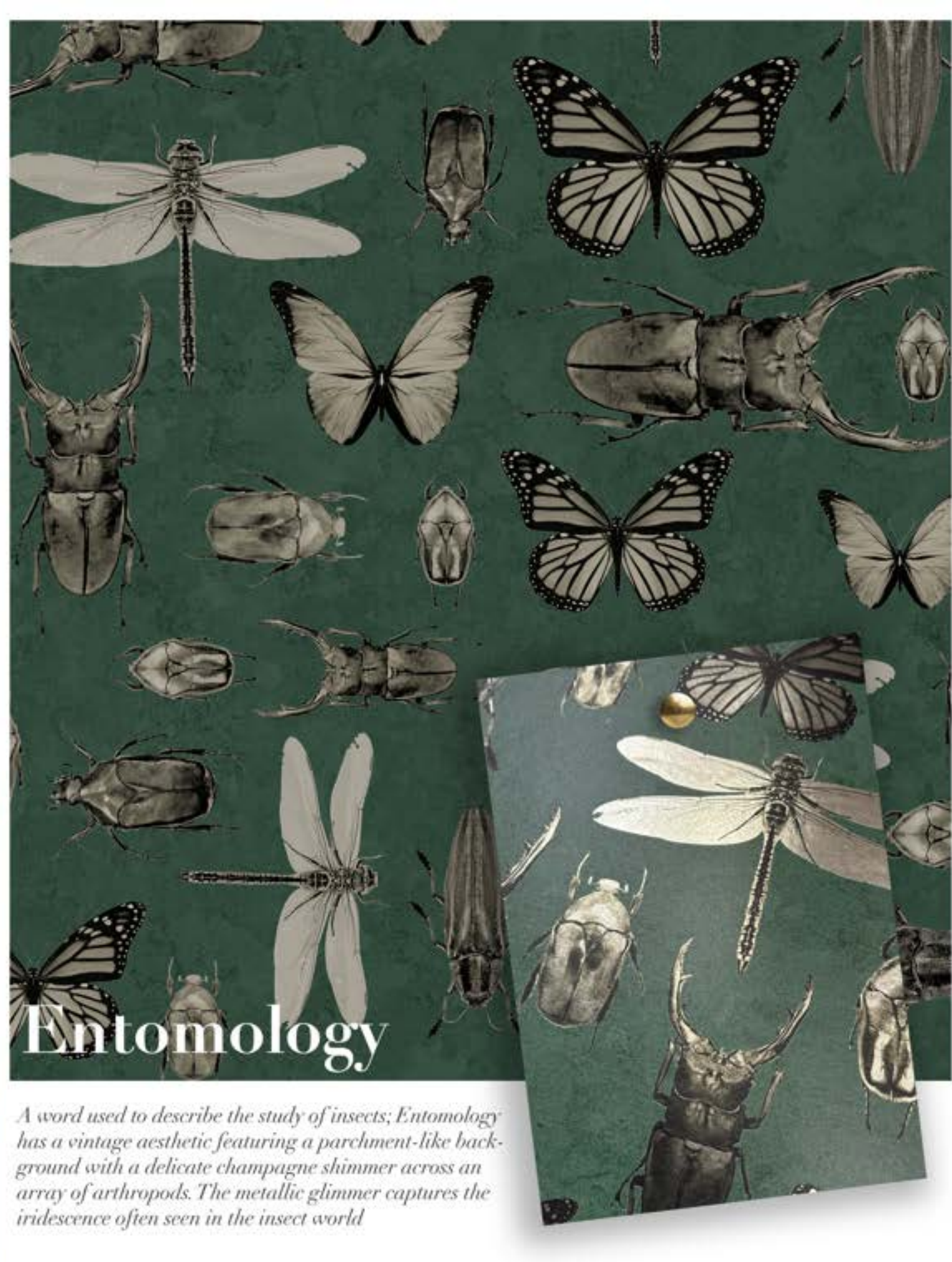
Entomology



Biblioteca

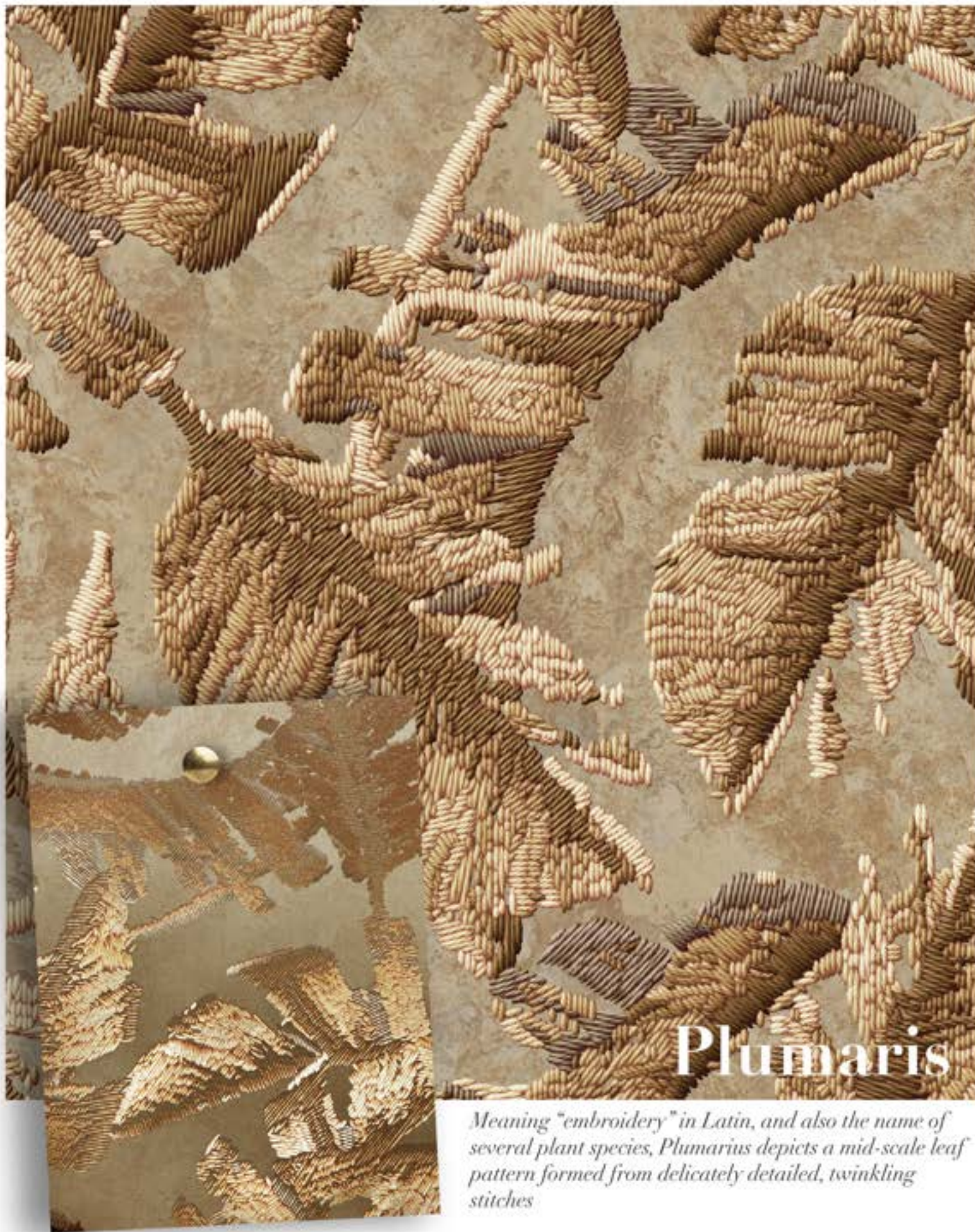

Plumaris

The Chesterfield sofa originated in 18th-century Britain, with its creation attributed to the Earl of Chesterfield. Featuring the now iconic button detailing and leather finishes, the style became associated with luxury and sophistication in high society.
