RECYCLED REMADE RENEWED

Waste wool yarn, wool fibre and wool-rich carpet waste doesn't need to end up in landfill.

Instead, we divert these materials to our Recycling Hub in Devon where they are recycled, remade and renewed into luxury underlay.

Axfelt Triple Layer Underlay is the ultimate sum of its parts. Unlike many other underlays on the market, Axfelt has three layers instead of two. Each layer uses a different material to provide the perfect combination:

LAYER 1 - 100% recycled yarn and wool fibre

LAYER 2 - 100% recycled wool yarn and wool-rich carpet waste

LAYER 3 - 100% recycled rubber made from recycled lorry and tractor tyres

These three layers are bound together with latex, and a polypropylene scrim is also added to stabilise the layers. This ensures a high quality and long-lasting product that contains more than 82% recycled content.

An additional benefit of creating this new flooring product from wool-rich waste is that you benefit from the natural characteristics of this amazing material, including durability and superb sound and heat insulation properties.

This is an excellent way to give all of these waste products a new lease of life.

WHY WOOL? WHY AXMINSTER?

The natural characteristics of wool and the inherent qualities of the Axminster weaving process work perfectly together to create quality carpet suitable for the demands of hospitality settings. Here are just some of the many benefits:

- Rapidly renewable - Wool is a sustainable material, with sheep regrowing their fleece every year.
- Durable - The Axminster weaving process enhances the natural strength and elasticity of wool.
- Resilient - This combination also adds resilience to flattening and crushing to provide long-term performance.
- Strength - Due to its three-dimensional structure, an Axminster carpet won't delaminate and resists issues of tuft loss, fraying and tearing.
- Safe and sound - Wool is flame resistant and does not easily ignite, melt, drip or release noxious fumes. The acoustic performance of a room can also be significantly improved by the use of a wool-rich carpet.

- Sourcing - High quality wool sourced from approved suppliers. We predominantly use British and Irish wool in our carpets with Scandinavian and New Zealand wool used for specific ranges/requirements.
- Processing - This wonderful raw material is processed into yarn by our expert company, Ulster Yarns, who have been producing premium woollen yarn in West Yorkshire since the Industrial revolution.
- Dyeing - Our state-of-the-art Dyehouse and Energy Centre in Northern Ireland can produce any colour imaginable.
- Design - Based in our dedicated Design Studios across the world, our talented Designers can turn your ideas into reality.
- Weaving - Using our patented PSYLO™ technology, we have a range of loom sizes to match your project requirements. Key control steps include a dedicated loom set up process and colour checks at looms.
- Finishing - Our three-stage quality control process includes the pre-shearer, inspection tables and finishing line and is carried out by skilled and experienced operatives.
- Custom Dispatch - The final control step involves every roll being manually inspected and cross-referenced with customer requirements.
- Full traceability - We can provide full traceability throughout the process for every order.


